SLEEP MEDICINE & TECHNOLOGY COURSE November 23rd - November 27th, 2009

A course for sleep professionals will be held by the David Read Laboratory, Department of Medicine, University of Sydney. The proposed dates for the next course are Monday 23rd November – Friday 27th November, 2009. We are happy to announce that once again Dr Sharon Keenan, from the School of Sleep Medicine, Palo Alto will lecture at the course. The faculty will also include a wide range of guest lecturers from Sydney and other Australian clinical and research centres.

The course programme is made up of formal lectures and small group practical sessions, which include "hands on" experience. The course starts from first principles, but also includes latest techniques, recent research findings and up to date clinical practice with lectures by experienced technologists, clinicians and researchers. A provisional course outline is enclosed. The practical teaching is structured to take the participants from the basic principles, through to the latest digital recording systems.

The fee is \$1,600 per student (for Australian and New Zealand sleep technicians) and \$1900 for overseas students and sleep/allied professionals. All prices include GST. Included in this fee is pre-course reading material, all tuition and handouts supplementing lecture material. Morning and afternoon tea will be provided. Accommodation is not included, but information about accommodation near the university is contained in another link.

Places in the course are limited to allow maximum participation in small group workshops and considerable interest has already been expressed in this course. As places will be allocated on a "first come" basis, potential participants are advised to register as soon as possible by returning the enclosed form with full payment or a deposit of \$500 to Sally Middleton at the above address.
